Applicants also submit that both Broadview Networks, Inc. and XO Communications, LLC operate in certain U.S. markets as non-dominant, competitive carriers of interstate and intrastate telecommunications services, and in each of the markets where both companies operate, robust competition from other nationwide and regional service providers exists. By way of example, the telecommunications market in New York is served by AT&T, Verizon, Level 3, Paetec, CenturyLink, and Windstream, among many other carriers.
