**ORDER**

On August 20, 2012, Game Show Network, LLC (“GSN”) and Cablevision Systems Corp. (“Cablevision”) filed Parties’ Joint Status Report as ordered by the Presiding Judge on August 8, 2012 in *Order*, FCC 12M-40. The Status Report indicated that discovery was proceeding smoothly, but raised three issues that GSN and Cablevision had yet to resolve: (1) the number of fact depositions to which each party is entitled; (2) the inclusion of Cablevision’s CEO as a custodian of files whose files will be searched for responsive documents; and (3) the appropriate sampling of hours and types of GSN programming that GSN will produce to Cablevision. It would be appropriate at this time that the non-governmental parties update the status of the respective parties’ document production efforts, including any resolution to the three issues noted above or any relief believed to be necessary for resolution.<sup>1</sup>

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that GSN and Cablevision submit a Joint Status Report **on or before October 10, 2012** on (1) the progress of document production since the filing of the Parties’ Joint Status Report; (2) the status of the three unresolved issues listed above; and (3) the existence of any other obstacles to discovery or refusals to produce documents that either party is confronting, if any.
