On September 24, 2012, Jeffrey Carlisle, Executive Vice President – Regulatory Affairs and Public Policy of LightSquared, and the undersigned of Latham & Watkins LLP, outside counsel to LightSquared, met with the Commission representatives listed below.

In that meeting, and as suggested in its prior advocacy in these proceedings,<sup>1</sup> LightSquared explained that it is preparing to make a comprehensive proposal that addresses the concerns that have been raised regarding GPS, while providing LightSquared the certainty it needs to deploy its terrestrial broadband network. LightSquared also briefly discussed the filing it made in these proceedings on September 24, 2012.
