Dear Mr. Turetsky:

On August 15, 2012, RSA 1 Limited Partnership d/b/a Chat Mobility, Iowa RSA 2 Limited Partnership d/b/a Chat Mobility, and Northwest Missouri Cellular Limited Partnership d/b/a NorthwestCell (collectively, the "Petitioners"), requested a waiver and a brief extension of the deadline by which the Petitioners were to have the capability to receive and transmit Commercial Mobile Alert System ("CMAS") alerts. Specifically, the Petitioners sought a limited extension until the completion of testing and the establishment of production connectivity between the Petitioner's Commercial Mobile Service Provider ("CMSP") Gateway and the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") Integrated Public Alert and Warning System ("IPAWS") Alert Aggregator Gateway in order to be able to receive and transmit CMAS alerts to their subscribers.

By this letter, the Petitioners inform the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission") that as of September 18, 2012, the Petitioners and FEMA established the necessary connectivity, and the Petitioners are now CMAS-capable.
