Pursuant to the Commission's December 13, 2011 *Report and Order* in the above captioned proceeding, I certify that:

1. Great Plains Cable Television has less than 15,000 subscribers and therefore meets the Commission's definition of a small MVPD system; and
2. Great Plains Cable Television needs a delay of one year to obtain specified equipment in order to avoid the financial hardship that would be imposed if it were required to obtain the equipment sooner.

I represent and warrant that the above certification is consistent with 47 C.F. R. § 1.17 which requires truthful and accurate statements to the Commission. I also acknowledge that false statements and misrepresentation to the Commission are punishable under Title 18 of the U.S. Code and may be subject to enforcement action.
