Dear Ms. Hindin:

On August 16, 2012, Liberty Media Corp. (Liberty Media) filed the above-captioned application for consent to the transfer of *de jure* control of Sirius XM Radio Inc. (Sirius) and the space station, satellite earth station, wireless, and experimental licenses held by Sirius and its subsidiaries.<sup>1</sup> Liberty included a request for waiver of the application signature requirement contained in Section 25.112(a) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.112(a). In Exhibit 1 to the waiver request, Sirius stated that it had "not signed the licensee and transferor portions of the applications because it is not in possession of all the facts required to make the certifications."

Pursuant to Sections 1.17 and 25.111 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.17 and 25.111, we request that Sirius provide a written statement as to whether the statements concerning Sirius contained in Section I.B. (pages eight and nine) of the Narrative portion of the application are true, complete and correct. Please support the response with an affidavit signed by an officer, director, or duly authorized employee.

We request that Sirius respond to this inquiry by September [3 business days], 2012.
