Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to advise that the undersigned, counsel for Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council ("AFTRCC"), had a telephone conversation today with Courtney Reinhard, Legal Assistant to Commissioner Pai. I discussed with Ms. Reinhard the issues which AFTRCC has raised during the reconsideration phase of this proceeding. Those issues are preservation of Rule 27.73's requirement that coordination be "consistent with Recommendation ITU-R M. 1459," use of the upper WCS band in the FDD configuration for downlink (base) stations as opposed to mobiles/portables, and requiring coordination for fixed WCS stations as well as base stations. I called attention to the fact that AFTRCC and AT&T had reached agreement on these issues as reflected in AT&T's ex parte filing of August 28.

A copy of this letter is being submitted for the docket.
