STREAMLINED FINANCIAL HARDSHIP WAIVER CERTIFICATION

CASA of Corpus Christi, L.P. (“Pappas Telecasting”), licensee of KXCC-CA, Corpus Christi, Texas (Facility ID No. 48834), hereby certifies that it requires a one-year delay to achieve compliance with the requirements of the Commercial Loudness Mitigation Act (the “CALM Act”) and, as set forth herein, requests waiver of the December 13, 2012 deadline for compliance. Pursuant to the streamlined waiver process set forth in the Commission’s December 13, 2011 *Report and Order* in this proceeding, Pappas Telecasting requests waiver for KXCC-CA as a “small broadcast station.”¹ Under the procedures adopted in the *Order*, a “small broadcast station” seeking a waiver must do so by certifying to the Commission that it qualifies as a “small broadcast station” and that it requires a delay of one year to obtain specified equipment to avoid financial hardship.²

As set forth in the attached Certification of Alice Heiserman, KXCC-CA certifies that it satisfies the definition of “small broadcast station” set forth in the *Order* by virtue of the fact that the station has less than \$14 million in annual receipts. KXCC-CA further certifies that to avoid


financial hardship, it requires a one-year delay to obtain certain specified equipment, as listed on Exhibit 1, necessary for KXCC-CA to comply with the Commission's CALM Act requirements.

Additionally, the equipment which KXCC-CA plans to implement to become compliant with the CALM Act requirements are: (i) the Linear Acoustic Digital Television Audio Processor Loudness Controller (or equivalent) and (ii) a Linear Acoustic Loudness Quality Monitor (or equivalent).

For the foregoing reasons, Pappas Telecasting respectfully requests a one-year waiver for KXCC-CA to comply with the CALM Act.



CERTIFICATION OF ALICE HEISERMAN

I, Alice Heiserman, hereby certify as follows:

1. I am General Ledger Accountant of CASA of Corpus Christi, L.P., licensee of television station KXCC-CA, Corpus Christi, Texas.
2. During calendar year 2011, KXCC-CA had less than \$14 million in annual receipts. It is anticipated that the station will also have less than \$14 million in annual receipts for 2012.
3. To achieve compliance with the Commission's CALM Act requirements at KXCC-CA, Pappas Telecasting must obtain (i) a Linear Acoustic Digital Television Audio Processor Loudness Controller (or equivalent) and (ii) a Linear Acoustic Loudness Quality Monitor (or equivalent).
4. To avoid financial hardship, Pappas Telecasting requires a one-year waiver of the Commission's CALM Act requirements to allow it to obtain the necessary equipment for KXCC-CA.
