We are appealing our 471 application for FRNs 2229170, 2229204, 2229234, 22292365, 2229300& 2229337. of form 471 # 819314.

In the Funding Commitment Decision Letter dated 4/3/2012 it states for

"MRI: The site-specific discount percentage was reduced to a level that could be validated based on third party data.

We appealed this directly with USAC and we sent in our survey results and a sample survey that qualifies us for a 90% discount during the appeal PIA. Our appeal was denied. (The letter was dated August 30, 2012). According the "Administrator's Decision on Appeal" letter it was denied because the results was not signed by a chief school official. We are appealing directly to the FCC because on August 27 we faxed the reviewer a survey results letter signed by Goldie Litvin the school's principal (that letter is included). It seems that reviewer overlooked that last fax.


