When I went to the front desk and talked to Louri I ask for a plunger and she gave a call on her phone and said that he will be bringing a plunger to my room. I started to walk back to my room and noticed children

children playing in one of the rooms below me as I walked up and a partially burned cigarette of the same brand that a man at the Jackson exit of the blue line bus in Chicago almost burned me with as he made a sudden motion to put a necklace around my head as he appeared unexpectedly after I took the escalator to the street level on September 8th before I went to the nearby Kinkos (September 10th actually) and the Kinkos closed early.
