Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 22, 2012, the undersigned spoke by telephone with David Goldman, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Jessica Rosenworcel regarding the above-named proceeding.

Specifically, I articulated CCIA's support for the Commission's 2 GHz rulemaking and urged the Commission to adopt its rules as proposed to permit new entry into the mobile broadband market. I indicated CCIA's support for developing a plan to auction the H Block, perhaps licensing it for small cell LTE build-out, that could obviate the need for much stricter out of band emissions limits on Dish Network. Dish's long planned investment in terrestrial facilities using 40MHz of spectrum available now should not be held hostage to a full tree of decisions on future auctioning of the much smaller, yet valuable H Block.
