Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 19, 2012, the undersigned, on behalf of JPMorgan Chase & Co., spoke separately by telephone with (1) Commissioner Robert M. McDowell, and (2) Matthew Berry, Chief of Staff for Commissioner Ajit Pai, regarding the above-referenced docket.

During the conversations, I reviewed the history of the filing for bankruptcy by the Tribune Company ("Tribune") in 2008, and the facts that the Bankruptcy Court's Order approving the Tribune's plan of reorganization is effective and that approval of the pending FCC applications is now the only regulatory hurdle remaining for Tribune to exit bankruptcy. I urged the Commission to act expeditiously on the applications, as necessary to allow Tribune to emerge from bankruptcy as soon as possible.

I also discussed the waivers that Tribune has requested in the pending applications, including in particular the waivers of the newspaper/broadcast cross-ownership rule that Tribune has requested in five markets.

Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b)(2), a copy of this notice is being filed electronically and a copy is being provided to the office of each Commission participant in the meeting.
