

Meeting Minutes

Meeting: WAC-15, Informal Working Group 2: Terrestrial Services (IWG-2)

Date/Time: 15 October 2012/ 10:00 a.m-12:00 p.m. (EDT)

Location: FCC, 445 12th St., SW, 5th Floor, Room 5-B516, Washington, D.C. 20554

Meeting Summary:

- 1) **Opening Remarks and Introductions:** The meeting of IWG-2 was called to order at 10:00 a.m. Participants were welcomed by IWG-2 Chair Charles Rush and Vice-Chair Jayne Stancavage. A roll call of participants present in the room and on the phone was conducted.
- 2) **Approval of Agenda:** The chair introduced the agenda in document **IWG-2/015 (09.10.12)**. The agenda was approved.
- 3) **Minutes:**
 - a. **Appointment of minute taker for the meeting:** Mr. Brennan Price agreed to take the minutes of the meeting.
 - b. **Approval of Minutes from IWG-2 Sept 19, 2012 Meeting:** The minutes of the last meeting as contained in document **IWG-2/014r1(09.10.12)** were approved without comments.
- 4) **Discussion and Approval of Draft IWG-2 Preliminary Views Document**
 - a. **WRC-15 Agenda Item 1.4: Secondary amateur 5 MHz allocation (Res. 649):** Document **IWG-2/017 (09.10.12)**, which represents the NTIA proposal on a Preliminary View for WRC-15 Agenda Item 1.4, was considered. The group opposed the proposed Preliminary View and noted that it was preferable to have no Preliminary View rather than this proposal go forward.
 - b. **WRC-15 Agenda Item 1.1; MBB/IMT (Res. 233):** Mr. Alex Roytblat provided an update on the outcome of the October 1, 2012 WAC meeting. He noted that regarding Agenda Item 1.1, both draft Preliminary Views (the first on 470-698 MHz and the second on 1215 MHz, 1215-1300 MHz, and 1559-1610 MHz) were approved by both the WAC and IRAC RCS. These documents are available on the FCC WAC website and will be submitted to CITELE. He also noted that the draft Preliminary View on Agenda Item 1.2 was approved by both the WAC and IRAC RCS and will be submitted to CITELE. The draft Preliminary Views on both Agenda Item 1.3 and Agenda Item 1.4 were approved by the WAC but not reconciled with the IRAC RCS view.
 1. **1435-1525 MHz:** Per a request from the author, document **IWG-2/012 (17.09.12)** will continue to be tabled and will be considered in the future.

2. **1695-1710 MHz:** No document was received regarding this spectrum yet. Ms. Veena Rawat mentioned that it would be useful to have a primary mobile allocation: she was advised to contact the author, Mr. Steve Sharkey, regarding the document.

3. **3400-4200 MHz:** Mr. Don Jansky introduced document **IWG-2/013 (17.09.12)** with a proposal for a draft Preliminary View on the 3400-4200 MHz frequency range. There was a discussion about the possibility of just deleting the last sentence in the proposed U.S. view but there was no agreement on the issue. The author agreed to work offline on another possible modification of the document.

4. **General Statement:** Document **IWG-2/016 (09.10.12)** was considered. The original intent of the document had been to provide a Preliminary View in the event that no consensus could be reached on Agenda Item 1.1. Given that consensus has now been reached on several Preliminary Views for Agenda Item 1.1, the author agreed to carry the document forward.

5) **Development of Draft Proposals:** Authors of WAC-approved Preliminary Views and other interested parties were encouraged to consider developing Draft Proposals. Additional draft Preliminary Views are also welcomed.

6) **Any Other Business:** No other business.

7) **Next meeting**

- The chair proposed that future meetings be held via telephone only unless circumstances change.
- The group agreed for the next meeting to be held on Monday, December 10, 2012; 1:00 pm-3:00 pm E.S.T.

The meeting was adjourned.
