(CBS) Two women have come forward and filed suit in New York against Minnesota Vikings quarterback Brett Favre for sexual harrassment. CBS News has obtained a copy of the lawsuit. The two women, Christina Scavo and Shannon O'Toole, are former massage therapists for the New York Jets, according to the suit. Scavo claims that then-New York Jets quarterback Favre wanted a three-way with her and another unnamed therapist. According to the lawsuit, Favre sent text messages to a third unnamed woman that read he wanted to "get together" with the woman and Scavo. Another text allegedly read, Brett here you and crissy want to get together im all alone. "Kinda lonely tonight, I guess I have bad intentions....", Favre writes in another text.

On April 14, 2012, a scandal involving U.S. President's security detail received international press attention. The scandal involved 11 agents and personnel from all four branches of the U.S. military; they allegedly engaged prostitutes while assigned to protect the U.S. President at the 6th Summit of the Americas in Cartagena, Colombia. According to ABC News, some Secret Service personnel are now also under investigation for possible drug use in Colombia. As of April 24, 2012 nine employees had resigned or retired. After the incident was publicized, the Secret Service implemented new rules for its personnel. The rules prohibit personnel from visiting "non-reputable establishments" and from consuming alcohol less than ten hours before starting work. Additionally, they restrict who is allowed in hotel rooms. A few weeks later, stories emerged of Secret Service agents hiring strippers and prostitutes prior to Obama's 2011 visit to El Salvador.

STATEMENT BY ASSISTANT DIRECTOR PAUL S. MORRISSEY

The following is a statement from Assistant Director Paul S. Morrissey, U.S. Secret Service Office of Government and Public Affairs:

On Saturday, April 14, 2012, allegations of misconduct were made against 11 Secret Service personnel in Cartagena, Colombia, in advance of the President's trip. These personnel were comprised of both special agents and Uniformed Division officers, none of whom are assigned to the Presidential Protective Division. The nature of the allegations, coupled with a zero tolerance policy on personal misconduct, resulted in the Secret Service taking the decisive action to relieve these individuals of their assignment, return them to their place of duty and replace them with additional Secret Service personnel. These actions have had no impact on the Secret Service's ability to execute a comprehensive security plan for the President's visit to Cartagena. This matter was turned over to our Office of Professional Responsibility, which serves as the agency's internal affairs component. The personnel involved were brought to Secret Service Headquarters in Washington, D.C., for interviews today. These interviews have been completed. As a result, all 11 employees have been placed on administrative leave. This is standard procedure and allows us the opportunity to conduct a full, thorough and fair investigation into the allegations. This matter is now in a personnel action phase which prohibits any comment per Secret Service policy. The Secret Service demands more from its employees and these expectations are met and exceeded every day by the vast majority of our workforce. This incident is not reflective of the behavior of our personnel as they travel every day throughout the country and the world performing their duties in a dedicated, professional manner. We regret any distraction from the Summit of the Americas this situation has caused.
