Dear Secretary Dortch and Vice President Majcher:

Pursuant to the requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 54.314, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PaPUC) hereby certifies to the Federal Communications Commission and the Universal Service Administrative Company that the telecommunications carriers, T-Mobile Northeast LLC, T-Mobile Central LLC and VoiceStream Pittsburgh LP (collectively, "T-Mobile"), are eligible to receive federal high-cost support for the program years cited.

The PaPUC certifies for T-Mobile that any federal high-cost support provided to such carriers within Pennsylvania was used in the preceding calendar year, 2011,^{1,2} and will be used in the coming calendar year, 2013, only for the provision, maintenance,³ and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended.³

High-cost support shall only be provided to the extent that the State has filed the requisite certification pursuant to this section.").
