The woman here at the Starbucks today called a taxi from her cell phone upon my request, however after going to the Best Buy and returning the woman mentioned that the taxi never di come (did it?). A call to APD from the non-emergency number yielded a busy signal when calling to inquire about the loss of the fifty dollar coat (bought after talking to the black officer in front of the Staples) as well as the Decker gloves that were stolen out of the storage space while all of the U-haul employees from the facility (except for Chuck and the hispanic man (the two that were there when "Marine" Luan was nere the enterance to the rear of the storage facility (and the visit that the bicycle's (from "Land of Entrapment" Pawn shop) shock was "unsealed" (now onther woman with a leopard skin key chai a tan shirt and blue jeans as stopped with her cell phone in front of the Starbucks window (11-13) before walking towards the enterance. She walked away when I started to type a description of her. Yesterday when I went to the Best Buy a large group of people crowded around the cell phones and with a young man with a sign in sheet. I ask one of the woman to get a cell phone from the rack but she said that I need

to talk to the man with the sign in sheet. Two pick up trucks pulled up to the Radio Shack and the manager said that he couldn't let me use the land line phone and then later let one of the men use the land line phone. A call to APD did not go through from the radio shacks land line phone.
