**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

The National Cable & Telecommunications Association (“NCTA”), pursuant to Section 1.46 of the Commission’s Rules, respectfully requests an extension of time for filing comments and reply comments on the Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the above-captioned proceeding to December 14, 2012 and January 14, 2013, respectively.

Hurricane Sandy has seriously disrupted business operations in many communities along the northeast corridor. In some cases, this has delayed and impaired the ability of NCTA’s cable operator and programmer members with offices in those communities to gather information from those offices and prepare comments in this proceeding. A two-week extension of time would ensure that these parties have sufficient time to prepare comments that fully address the multiple questions and proposals in the Further Notice.

A similar two-week extension of time for the filing of reply comments would require those comments (which are currently due only 15 days after the filing of initial comments) to be prepared during the holiday period of the last two weeks of December. Accordingly, NCTA requests that, in addition to extending the time for filing initial comments by two weeks, the Commission extend the time for filing reply comments to January 14, 2013.
