

Hardship Waiver**


**In the Matter of the Commercial Advertisement Loudness
Mitigation ("CALM")**

MB Docket No. 11-93

On behalf of Cablevision of Marion County, LLC. (FRN# 0011406675) serving Marion County, Florida ("COMC"), I, Kerri L. King, hereby request a streamlined financial hardship waiver of the Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation (CALM) Act rules for one year.

Pursuant to the December 13, 2011, Report and Order in the above-captioned proceedings, I certify that COMC: 1) has fewer than 5,000 subscribers and therefore meets the Commission's definition of a small MVPD system; and 2) needs a delay of one year to avoid the financial hardship that would otherwise be imposed if it were required to obtain sooner the necessary audio monitoring equipment.

I represent and warrant that the above certification is consistent with 47.C.F.R. § 1.17 which requires truthful and accurate statements to the Commission. I also acknowledge that false statements and misrepresentations to the Commission are punishable under Title 18 of the U.S. Code and may subject COMC to enforcement action.
