**STREAMLINED FINANCIAL HARDSHIP WAIVER CERTIFICATION**

1. By this pleading and the attached certificate, Encuentro Christian Network Corp. (“Licensee”), licensee of full-power digital television station WECN(DT), Facility ID 19561, Naranjito, Puerto Rico, hereby certifies that WECN(DT) requires a one-year delay to achieve compliance with the requirements of the Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation Act (the “CALM Act”) and requests a waiver of the December 13, 2012 deadline for compliance.<sup>1</sup>

2. Pursuant to the streamlined waiver process set forth in the Commission’s December 13, 2011 *Report and Order* in this proceeding, Licensee requests waiver for WECN(DT) as a “small broadcast station.”<sup>2</sup> Under the procedures adopted in the *Order*, a station seeking a waiver on this basis must certify to the Commission that it qualifies as a “small broadcast station” and that it requires a delay of one year to obtain specified equipment to avoid financial hardship.<sup>3</sup>

3. As set forth in the attached Certification of its President, Licensee certifies that WECN(DT) satisfies the definition of “small broadcast station” by virtue of having less than \$14 million in gross annual receipts. Licensee further certifies that, to avoid financial hardship, the Licensee requires a one-year delay to obtain certain the equipment necessary for WECN(DT) to comply with the Commission’s CALM Act requirements.

4. Accordingly, Encuentro Christian Network Corp. respectfully requests a one-year waiver for WECN(DT) to comply with the CALM Act.



**CERTIFICATION OF RAFAEL I. TORRES PADILLA**

Rafael I. Torres Padilla hereby certifies as follows:

1. I am President of Encuentro Christian Network Corp., a Puerto Rico non-profit corporation.
2. Encuentro Christian Network Corp. is FCC licensee of full-power digital television station WECN (DT), Facility ID 19561, Naranjito, Puerto Rico.
3. During calendar year 2011, WECN (DT) – which is operated as a noncommercial station – had less than \$14 million in annual receipts. It is anticipated that WECN (DT) will also have less than \$14 million in annual receipts for 2012.
4. To achieve compliance with the Commission's CALM Act requirements, WECN (DT) must install certain equipment, including a loudness controller device and software, to ensure compliance.
5. As initial estimates have indicated that the costs for such equipment will be a minimum of several thousand dollars, Encuentro Christian Network Corp. requires a one-year waiver of the Commission's CALM Act requirements for WECN (DT) to allow it time to raise the necessary funds to obtain the necessary equipment while avoiding financial hardship.
