Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 6, Alan Braverman (Senior Executive Vice President, General Counsel & Secretary, The Walt Disney Company), Susan Fox, (Vice President, The Walt Disney Company), and Bill Bailey (Vice President, Government Relations, The Walt Disney Company) met with Commissioner Ajit Pai. During a broad conversation, the Disney executives very briefly raised concerns with a December 4 Media Bureau Order in this proceeding that granted in part and denied in part a request by Comcast/NBCU with respect to access to peer programming deals. In particular, Ms. Fox stressed the importance of maintaining the confidentiality of proprietary commercial information. These competitive concerns were made more fully as part of a Joint Opposition filed in this proceeding on April 3, 2012 (at pages 10-15 of that filing).

Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, an original and one copy of this letter are being filed as notice of this conversation. The proceeding at issue is considered permit-but-disclose, and therefore presentations are permitted, but must be disclosed.
