

On behalf of our client, Prime Time Christian Broadcasting, Inc. ("PTCB"), licensee of Stations KPTB(DT), Lubbock, Texas, KPCB-DT, Snyder, Texas, KPTF-DT, Farwell, Texas, KMLM-DT, Odessa, Texas, and KRPV-DT, Roswell, New Mexico, this is a CALM Act streamlined financial hardship waiver request, filed in accordance with *CALM Act Report and Order*, 26 FCC Rcd 17222, 17253-56 (2011), and *Memorandum Opinion and Order*, DA 12-2013, released December 11, 2012. FINANCIAL HARDSHIP WAIVER CERTIFICATION
UNDER CALM ACT

I am the President of Prime Time Christian Broadcasting, Inc. ("PTCB"), licensee of Stations KPTB(DT), Lubbock, Texas, KPCB-DT, Snyder, Texas, KPTF-DT, Farwell, Texas, KMLM-DT, Odessa, Texas, and KRPV-DT, Roswell, New Mexico. This Certification has been prepared as the basis for a request for a one-year delay in compliance with the CALM Act equipment requirements, pursuant to *CALM Act Report and Order*, 26 FCC Rcd 17222, 17253-56 (2011), and *Memorandum Opinion and Order*, DA 12-2013, released December 11, 2012.

1. I hereby certify, under penalty of perjury, that our five above-described full-power TV stations qualify separately and together as stations with no more than \$14.0 million in annual receipts.

2. I hereby certify, under penalty of perjury, that PTCB needs a delay of one year – until December 13, 2013 – to purchase the following equipment that we need for CALM Act compliance in order to avoid the financial hardship that would be imposed if PTCB were required to obtain the equipment sooner:
 - (a) Two (2) CALM audio processors to maintain our audio output within specified parameters. These processors would be located at our Odessa master control point for the main and backup parallel outputs of our satellite feed; and

 - (b) At least four (4) spot check audio monitors to verify that the outputs at our main satellite uplink and backup uplink at Odessa are within specified parameters.

3. The Commission's understanding in this matter is greatly appreciated. For the reasons stated in this Certification, PTCB respectfully requests a one-year waiver of the CALM Act compliance deadline until December 13, 2013 for its five stations.
