On December 5, 2012, FairPoint Communications, Inc. ("FairPoint") and Blackfoot Telephone Cooperative, Inc. d/b/a Blackfoot Telecommunications Group ("Blackfoot") submitted the above-captioned application for Commission consent to transfer control of Fremont Telcom Co. ("Fremont") and Fretel Communications, LLC ("Fretel"). The parties also provided a list of affected exchanges as a supplement to the application on December 11, 2012. By this letter, FairPoint is updating the Fremont list of exchanges to remove two exchanges that were improperly listed and submitting a revised, corrected list of Fremont exchanges. The parties are also submitting two maps reflecting the service areas of their incumbent local exchange carrier ("ILEC") operations and their competitive local exchange carrier ("CLEC") operations in both Idaho and Montana
