On December 17 and December 20, Dan Luis from Purple Communications, Inc. (“Purple”) talked on the telephone with Priscilla Delgado Argeris of Commissioner Rosenworcel’s office on the topics of; i) trends in IP-Captioned Telephone Service (“IP-CTS”) and potential steps the Commission might take to ensure continued availability of these services, and ii) VRS reform, emphasizing that the record reflects the concentration of VRS overpayment is with a single provider, not the entire industry. Our discussions were consistent with our ex partes filed on December 14 and December 17 on each of those topics.
