Pursuant to the Commission's Order dated May 23, 2012, CC Docket No. 91-281, the John F. Kennedy Space Center (KSC) files this report concerning its activities under the waiver granted to the Calling Party Number regulations at 47 C.F.R. 64.1601(b).

During the first six months in which the waiver has been in effect, KSC has commenced the installation of all necessary equipment and has documented the procedures to be used under the waiver granted by the Commission. It was also necessary, however, to obtain a contract modification from KSC's carrier, AT&T, incorporating the new capability to access Calling Party Numbers. Extended negotiations regarding the terms and conditions of this modification were just concluded on December 13, 2012, and we expect to execute the modification and finalize equipment hook-up shortly thereafter.

Due to the time necessary to undertake the above-mentioned preparations, KSC has not used the waiver granted under the subject Order and, therefore, there is no data to report demonstrating whether and how this waiver has enhanced the ability of security personnel to ensure the safety of employees. With all preparations nearing completion, KSC will provide any and all responsive data to the Commission in the 18 month report required by the Order.
