

Hi,

Since our public tv broadcast converted to digital signal about three years ago, I went through 3 digital signal converter box in one and half year. The converter boxes always worked fine in the beginning. But the boxes will gradually loses the abilities to convert digital signals to ntsc signals.

One year ago, I decided to get a brand new sony led tv. Of course this tv connects directly to the outdoor antenna. We can get most of the public channels. However, for the past month, we are having the same troubles with decreasing picture qualities and losing many channels. By the way, once we lose the channels, they don't come back. This is behaving exactly the same as the digital boxes that we had for the old ntsc tvs.

I am pretty sure if I connect the same antenna cable to a new led tv, most of the channels will be displayed without any problems. If I am going to rescan, my current led tv, for the channels again, most of them will be gone because the tv will not regonizes the channels. This won't be long until no channels will be displayed.

Please advise.
