**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE SUPPLEMENT TO APPLICATION FOR REVIEW
AND REPLY TO OPPOSITION**

KSQA, L.L.C, licensee of commercial television station KSQA, Channel 12, Topeka, Kansas, by its attorneys, pursuant to Section 1.3 of the Commission Rules, hereby files this Motion seeking a waiver of the filing deadlines in Section 1.115 of the Commission’s Rules, and requesting leave to file the accompanying “Supplement to Application for Review and Reply to Opposition” (“Supplement”). As the Supplement explains, there has been a significant development since the filing of KSQA’s Application for Review. That development is the issuance of the *Channel 12 Letter*,¹ which directly contradicts the holding in the *Dismissal Order*, which is the subject of the Application for Review.

The issuance of the *Channel 12 Letter* requires a review and reversal of the *Dismissal Order*. The public interest will be served by grant of this Motion, because it will allow the Commission to have the two conflicting orders before it in its deliberations on this matter.




