

On December 23, 2012, the undersigned counsel to Wavecom Solutions Corporation (“Wavecom”) had a telephone conversation with Julie Veach, Chief of the Wireline Competition Bureau regarding applications to transfer control of Wavecom’s FCC licenses and authorizations to Hawaiian Telcom, Inc. (“HTI”). The undersigned discussed Wavecom’s growing financial difficulties and requested expedited completion of its review to permit the transaction to close before the end of the year.

Wavecom is experiencing significant financial distress, which is exacerbated the longer closing the transaction is delayed. **[Begin Confidential Information]**
