
Re: Reply Comments, Dockets 12-1863, 12-340, RM-11683

Dear Chairman Genachowski:

Incentives in rural America excite me. As a lifelong Mississippian, we have both opportunities and challenges that are uniquely ours. Commonly, we adapt a new technology; a new application; a new business model beneficial to our rural communities. This is not dissimilar to wholesale model that LightSquared has applied to its business. Their network will no doubt spur competition in the industry, but, more relevant to me, expand the nation's broadband capacity by reaching many communities, like those in rural Mississippi, that are currently underserved.

The FCC has made recent comments about making much more spectrum available for mobile broadband, and, no doubt, something must be done to provide better access in rural America. I hope you will give LightSquared's application for license modification extensive consideration, and approve their request to share spectrum with the federal government. I see this as the only way that the whole of Mississippi will gain access to affordable broadband, and LightSquared's wholesale approach will benefit the entire industry.
