Dear Ms. Dortch,

On January 9, 2013, Jonathan Adelstein, President and CEO of PCIA—The Wireless Infrastructure Association (“PCIA”), W. Benjamin Moreland, President and CEO of Crown Castle International, and the undersigned (“parties”) met with Ruth Milkman, Jane Jackson, Maria Kirby, Jeffrey Steinberg, and Peter Trachtenberg of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. Discussion at the meeting focused on advances in wireless infrastructure and small cell technologies and deployment practices and issues impacting the efficient buildout of advanced wireless networks.

Further, the parties urged the FCC to clarify the terms of section 6409(a) of the Middle Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act of 2012<sup>1</sup> consistent with the FCC rules and prior findings on the record in analogous proceedings. Such clarifications will support the Commission’s goal of enabling the delivery of broadband to all Americans.
