
On behalf of small business owners, I encourage you to favorably consider the modified license application of LightSquared. The potential for better broadband access, better prices and new applications that come with the build out of a national broadband network.

As the comments filed in these proceedings reveal, there is almost universal agreement that the FCC should facilitate the use of limited spectrum resources and move forward with LightSquared's proposal to bring a significant chunk of spectrum to bear in the provision of a wholesale-only nationwide 4G mobile broadband network. As many parties noted, LightSquared's wholesale provision of this service opens up this spectrum for not just one competitor, but almost an infinite number of current and potential players in the wireless market. For example, LightSquared's planned network would allow smaller regional wireless operators like PowerNet Global (PNG) to access a previously intangible network of opportunities.

Huber Heights rests on the northern side of Dayton; while we boast a large population and are adjacent to a large metropolitan city, farmland quickly surrounds the eastern and northern parts of Huber Heights. To support LightSquared's efforts is to positively champion a more robust pace for consumers' access to wireless broadband services, actualize nationwide 4G service to rural and underserved areas, as well as foster new entrants in the wireless market allowing new innovative business models to increase consumers' overall access to wireless broadband services. The Beacon Lounge sits on the eastern edge of Huber Heights: apparently not only do the city limits end near our establishment, but so does broadband service!
