Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 7, 2013, Deutsche Telekom AG (“Deutsche Telekom”) and T-Mobile USA, Inc. (“T-Mobile USA”) (together, the “Parties”) filed their response to the FCC Information and Document Request of December 20, 2012 (the “Response”), in the above-referenced docket. As part of that Response, the Parties provided a series of files in response to Requests 12 and 14 of the Information Request on a disk labeled TMUS\_DEN\_90000001. On January 11, 2013, the Parties resubmitted the file labeled “FCC question 12 Utilization HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL,” provided in response to Request 12, on a disk labeled “TMUS\_DEN\_90000003 in order to correct certain errors identified in the original file. TMUS\_DEN\_90000003 replaced TMUS\_DEN\_90000001 in its entirety.

Pursuant to discussions with FCC staff, the Parties are resubmitting the “FCC question 12 Utilization HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL” file on the attached disk labeled TMUS\_DEN\_90000004 to correct a data corruption issue identified in the version provided on TMUS\_DEN\_90000003. Also pursuant to discussions with FCC staff, the Parties are resubmitting the files provided in response to Request 14 of the Information Request to provide, at the FCC’s request, additional breakdowns of the cost per gross add data previously provided as well as an updated data
