Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, DISH Network Corporation ("DISH") submits this letter summarizing a meeting on Friday, January 11, 2013 with Tom Peters, Chief Engineer, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; John Leibovitz, Deputy Chief, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (by telephone); Blaise Scinto, Chief, Broadband Division, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; Jeremy Marcus, Assistant Chief, Broadband Division, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (by telephone); Chris Helzer, Broadband Division, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; Janet Young, Broadband Division, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; Ron Repasi, Deputy Chief, Office of Engineering Technology (by telephone); and Michael Ha, Office of Engineering and Technology. Present on behalf of DISH were Jeffrey Blum, Senior Vice President and Deputy General Counsel; Mariam Sorond, Vice President, Technology Development; Alison Minea, Corporate Counsel; and Hadass Kogan, Associate Corporate Counsel.

During the meeting, DISH reiterated its desire to enter the wireless market expeditiously, following the December 2012 adoption of final rules in the above-referenced proceedings.<sup>1</sup>

DISH discussed various options to address the 3rd Generation Partnership Project (“3GPP”) standard-setting process for the AWS-4 band in light of the *AWS-4 Order*. Among other things, DISH stressed that any efforts to accommodate AWS-4 spectrum at 3GPP should not be delayed pending the outcome of the Commission’s ongoing H Block proceeding.<sup>2</sup>
