

I understand that the FCC will soon begin a review and possible revision of its media ownership rules, which set limits on the ownership of multiple television and radio stations and newspapers in a single commercial market.

My wife and I reside in Fort Collins, which is served by the Denver television, radio and newspaper market.

We oppose any relaxation of ownership rules that would decrease competition and lessen the number of available voices that report the news. Further relaxation of the rules would not ensure that media ownership rules continue to protect consumer interests in today's marketplace, but rather serve only to increase the profits of a further and further monopolized media market.

We also strongly urge you to seek public comments through public meetings in the top 20 media markets, including Denver. We are very concerned that public input is unduly being limited in this ongoing process. Thank You.
