MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Respondent Atlantic Broadband hereby files this Motion for Extension of Time to extend the pleading cycle in the above-captioned Must Carry Complaint for three weeks, through February 12, 2013. Respondent is authorized to represent that Complainant Western Pacific Broadcast LLC, Licensee of WACP-TV (“Western Pacific”) does not object to this one week extension.

On December 17, the Commission placed on public notice a Must Carry complaint filed by Western Pacific against Atlantic Broadband with respect to carriage of WACP on one of Atlantic Broadband’s cable systems serving the Philadelphia Designated Market Area. *See* Public Notice, Special Relief and Show Cause Petitions, Rpt. No. 0388 (Dec. 17, 2012). Under the Commission’s rules, Atlantic Broadband’s Answer was initially due on January 7, 2013, while Western Pacific’s Reply would have been due on Thursday, January 17, 2013. On January 7, 2013, and subsequently on January 14, 2013, however, Atlantic Broadband filed Motions for Extension of Time, each for a one week period, which the Commission granted. Today, Atlantic Broadband

requests a three week extension of the pleading schedule, extending the time for its Answer to February 12, and the time for Western Pacific's Reply to February 22, 2013.

Atlantic Broadband and Western Pacific continue attempts to resolve their issues, and believe they may be able to do so without the need for Commission intervention. In order to give both parties the opportunity to extend those discussions—and with the aim of preserving scarce Commission resources—Atlantic Broadband, without objection from Western Pacific, respectfully requests that the Commission extend the pleading cycle by one week, such that Atlantic Broadband's Answer would be due on **Tuesday, February 12, 2013**, and Western Pacific's Reply would be due on **Friday, February 22, 2013**.
