
The undersigned Executive Director and General Counsel of the National Association of Black Owned Broadcasters, Inc. ("NABOB"), pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, submits this notice of a series of *ex parte* presentations to decision-making personnel of the Commission. As a result of the discussions and communications I had with those decision-making personnel, NABOB is prepared to consider a compromise on the issue of relaxation of the radio-newspaper cross-ownership rule.

The compromise would provide that: a radio station licensee would be permitted to own a daily newspaper in the same market as its radio stations, provided the licensee owns no more than two radio stations in that market. In the smallest markets, where two stations would comprise a substantial portion of the stations in the market, the radio station licensee would be allowed to own only one station and a daily newspaper.

The compromise reported here resulted from the following presentations, at which various other compromises were discussed:

1. A meeting on January 22, 2013 with Commissioner Jessica Rosenworcel and Alex Hoehn-Saric, Policy Director, and follow-up telephone conversations with Mr. Hoehn-Saric on January 23, 2013.
2. A meeting on January 22, 2013 with Commissioner Robert McDowell and Erin A. McGrath, Legal Advisor, Media. A portion of this meeting was attended by David Honig and Maurita Coley of the Minority Media and Telecommunications Council.
3. A meeting on January 22, 2013, with Elizabeth Andrion, Legal Advisor to Chairman Julius Genachowski, William Lake, Chief, Media Bureau, Dave Grimaldi, Chief of Staff and Media Legal Advisor to Commissioner Mignon Clyburn, attended by David Honig and Maurita Coley, and follow-up conversation on January 23 with Ms. Andrion.
4. A meeting on January 23, 2013, with Commissioner Ajit Pai and Matthew Berry, Chief of Staff.
5. A telephone conversation on January 23, 2013, with Commissioner Mignon Clyburn and Dave Grimaldi.
