On January 23, 2013, Mo Katibeh, Brooks Fitzsimmons, Anisa Latif, and I—all from AT&T Services, Inc. (AT&T)—met with David Turetsky, Jeff Goldthorp, John Healy, Lauren Kravetz, Julia Tu, Gregory Intoccia, Behzad Ghaffari, Rasoul Safavian, and Mike Sherling of the FCC's Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss AT&T's emergency management response during and after Hurricane Sandy. During this meeting, Mr. Turetsky raised an issue pending in the above-referenced proceeding, specifically, whether AT&T would be interested in allowing the Commission to share Disaster Information Reporting System (DIRS) data with state officials during disasters to alleviate carriers from providing data to multiple sources. We offered no opinion on this matter and agreed to follow-up with the Commission after the meeting.
