

I would like the FCC to require that high speed internet service providers be required to advertise and supply customers with a minimum speed of service. I am currently paying \$25 a month (before \$5 discount that I demanded) for a speed advertised at up to 768 kbps from At&t. I have tested my speed and lately rarely if ever get the max speed.
