ASL Services Holdings, LLC (“GraciasVRS”) hereby notifies the Commission’s Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau of a service interruption occurring this morning, February 13, 2013, between 2:35 PM and 2:40 Eastern Time, to upgrade to GraciasVRS’ MMX platform software.

No subscribers were impacted by this service upgrade.
