Dear Ms. Dortch:

On February 4, 2013, Mr. Jim Rowe of the Alaska Telephone Association, Mr. Kip Knudsen and Mr. Nathan Butzlaff of Alaska Governor Sean Parnell's Washington, DC based staff, and I met at the FCC's offices with Commissioner Ajit V. Pai and his legal advisor, Mr. Nicholas Degani. Our discussion touched on how Alaska's lack of roads and electric grids as well as other factors such as extensive reliance on satellite make application of national models to Alaska's service providers inappropriate. We also discussed how regulatory uncertainty is hampering Alaska's carriers' ability to invest and borrow the funds needed to move towards universal broadband.

Additionally we reviewed the importance of universal and affordable voice service, including mobility, if broadband service is not feasible in parts of Alaska for the time being, and how access to the internet, while expensive in remote parts of Alaska, provides much greater value than it may in other parts of the country.
