On February 20, 2013, Drew Fonoroff, Greg Wagner, Terri Hoskins, Victoria Carter Hall, Jeanine Poltronieri, Colleen Thompson and the undersigned of AT&T spoke by telephone with Ken Lynch, Chelsea Fallon and John Emmett of the Wireline Competition Bureau and Nese Guendelsberger, Melvin Del Rosario, Thuy Tran and Ben Freeman of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau regarding the above-listed proceeding. The discussion was an extension of a prior discussion of potential changes under consideration for the Form 477 data collection process and their impact on providers' burden in preparation of their submissions.¹

AT&T's representatives described the manner in which AT&T provides shape file and speed tier data to the state mapping entities in support of NTIA's state broadband initiative. The manner in which AT&T provides mapping information to Mosaic Solutions was also discussed.
