

The frequencies between 1900 and 2000 KHz would be an important resource for both routine use and for emergency communications use. This is especially so in light of the rapidly increasing Amateur Radio population in the United States. Available Amateur Radio frequencies have not kept pace with the number of licensed operators.

- December 1981: 433,000
- December 1991: 494,000
- December 2001: 683,000
- September 2011: 700,221

Currently, Amateur Radio is now at an all-time high of 710,000 people in the United States and and still continuing to grow.
