2. I am a dentist with specialty training in Prosthodontics.

 1. My interest in this field started when I became aware of a low frequency sound present everywhere in my environment, months of research point to ELF frequencies in mobile communication technology and their use in the “smart grid” as the likely cause.
 2. As the mother of two young children I am concerned about the indiscriminate deployment of WiFi in schools without any regard for safety.
