After thorough review and investigation of all relevant facts, the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) has made its decision in regard to your appeal of USAC's Funding Year 2011 Form 486 Notification Letter for the Application Number indicated above. This letter explains the basis of USAC's decision. The date of this letter begins the 60 day time period for appealing this decision to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). If your Letter of Appeal included more than one Application Number, please note that you will receive a separate letter for each application.

Decision on Appeal: **Denied**
Explanation:

- The record shows that the original Funding Commitment Decision Letter (FCDL) dated January 31, 2012 approved funding in part for the services covered by this request. Per program rules, the 120 day deadline for filing Forms 486 is determined based on the date of the original FCDL that approved funding for the request(s). USAC has determined that your FCC Form 486 was not filed within 120 days calculated from January 31, 2012, the date of the FCDL or July 1, 2011, the Service Start Date (SSD) indicated on the FCC Form 486, whichever date is later. On July 11, 2012, USAC mailed an "Urgent Reminder" letter providing you with additional time and a new deadline to submit and/or certify your FCC Form 486. The FCC Form 486 Application Number 919230 was postmarked on August

30, 2012 which is after the new deadline. Consequently, the SSD was revised to May 2, 2012, 120 days before the FCC Form 486 Certification postmark date. If the funding commitment includes recurring charges then the funding commitment has been reduced accordingly. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that all forms are submitted to USAC in a correct and timely manner. As a result, your appeal is denied.

- FCC rules require applicants to use recurring services within the relevant funding year and to implement non-recurring services by the applicable deadline established by the Commission. *See* 47 C.F.R. sec. 54.507(d).
