Dear Ms. Dortch:

By this letter and in accordance with paragraph 101 of the Federal Communication Commission's *Report and Order* and *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* CC Docket Nos. 02-33 and 01-337 released September 23, 2005, FCC 05-150 ("*Broadband Internet Order*"), the Windstream Local Operating Companies ("Windstream") listed below hereby notify the Commission that Windstream intends to discontinue offering common carrier Digital Subscriber Line (DSL) service on a common carriage basis and will offer this service on a private carriage basis effective April 1, 2013. These companies recently converted from Average Schedule to Price Cap regulation and are currently offering DSL on a non-tariffed basis. The geographic areas affected by this change are the areas serviced by the companies listed below where DSL is available.


