On March 4, 2013, Milo Medin, Vice President of Access Services, Google Inc., spoke by telephone with Chairman Julius Genachowski and Tejas Narechania, Special Counsel, Office of General Counsel, concerning Google Fiber's deployment of its Gigabit network and broadband services in Kansas City, Kansas, and Kansas City, Missouri. In the course of that conversation, Mr. Medin identified measures the Commission could take to lower barriers to the deployment of Gigabit networks by various providers nationwide. The identified measures included program access reform. Austin Schlick, Google's Director, Communications Law, attended the call but did not participate in Mr. Medin's presentation.
