Pursuant to the Memorandum Opinion and Order in the above-referenced proceeding released on March 5, 2013, paragraph 18, AT&T Inc., on behalf of its affiliates, ("AT&T") informs the International Bureau of a settlement rate increase on the U.S.-Pakistan route imposed effective on or around October 1, 2012. AT&T's affiliate, AT&T Corp. ("ATTC") was informed by its correspondent carrier in Pakistan by letter dated August 31, 2012 that the official settlement rate for all international traffic terminating in Pakistan would be US\$ 0.088 effective on October 1, 2012. ATTC was asked to implement this increased rate on that date.
