**REQUEST FOR FURTHER  
EXTENSION OF TIME**

AT&T Mobility, LLC (“AT&T”) and Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless, under Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) rule 1.46, file this Request for Further Extension of Time to file Comments in the above referenced docket.

In the applications listed below, AT&T requested a waiver of Commission rules 22.911(d) and 1.923(a) to allow AT&T to extend service area boundaries (“SAB”) for certain cellular licensees into the cellular geographic service areas (“CGSA”) of neighboring cellular licenses held by Verizon Wireless or its affiliates.<sup>1</sup> On February 5, 2013, the Commission placed AT&T’s waiver requests on Public Notice, setting a cycle of February 20, 2013 for comments and March 6, 2013 for replies. At the request of AT&T and Verizon Wireless, the Commission extended the comment cycle to March 22, 2013 and April 5, 2013 to provide the opportunity for those parties to negotiate extension agreements.

Over the last 30 days, AT&T and Verizon Wireless have made significant progress in obtaining the extension agreements needed by both carriers. As of this date, AT&T has received

all extension agreements needed to resolve seven of the twelve applications pending at the Commission without pending extension agreement exhibits—4857416, 5029092, 5052335, 5000972, 4917209, 5029078, and 5069758.<sup>2</sup> Extension agreements for the remaining five applications listed in the attached Exhibit A are in various states of approval or negotiation, with resolution expected in the near future.

AT&T and Verizon Wireless request a further extension of the comment cycle of thirty (30) days to allow time to complete consent on the written extension agreements. This extension will not prejudice any other parties. Good cause exists to grant this extension, as allowing AT&T and Verizon Wireless to resolve these outstanding extension agreement issues will promote ubiquitous coverage and minimize unserved areas in cellular market areas. This request for extension applies to the waivers attached to the pending applications filed by AT&T identified in Exhibit A hereto.
