Radio North, in an effort to protect individual LTR customer "CPNI" (Customer Proprietary network information), We do not publish our frequencies or each individual customers personal ID which keeps their communications private. We do not offer interconnect or VOIP on data transport on this system, it is strictly a two-way voice system.

When invoicing the customer, we do not publish their specific id, we send out an invoice with a generic statement, for tower service, for the month in question. Further, our billing computer, is not on any network, or accessible by any outside entity, including the web.

Should we have any instances, where a customer calls and complains that they can hear another user we will fix the problem within 24 hours. We do not share the names of users on our system with any other user or entity.

Should a customer call, we would confirm that they are whom they state, by verifying the identity of the caller and that they are indeed the designated contact.

We have never had any cases of breach of CPNI, and we will continue to do everything in our power to ensure this in the future.


