**AMENDMENT TO REQUEST FOR REVIEW – FY 2011 DISCOUNT PERCENTAGE  
ADJUSTMENT – FILED ON AUGUST 28, 2012**

1) On August 28, 2012, Wakisha Charter School filed an appeal<sup>1</sup> with respect to the captioned funding year 2011 form 471 funding request. This appeal was filed in response to the appeal that Wakisha filed with the Schools and Libraries Division (“SLD”) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (“USAC”) on May 12, 2012, which was only partially approved on June 29, 2012. It is our understanding that our August 28, 2012 appeal is still pending before the Commission.

2) On January 11, 2013, SLD sent correspondence<sup>2</sup> to Wakisha Charter School, advising the school that the original May 12, 2012 appeal was being reconsidered by SLD. On January 29, 2013, SLD only partially approved our appeal again<sup>3</sup>.

3) After this additional decision from SLD, the school would like to reassert its position with the FCC based on our original August 28, 2012 appeal, that it believes it is entitled, based on the documentation submitted, to a 90% discount on e-rate eligible services.

4) Therefore, based on the information previously presented, we would respectfully request the Commission reverse USAC's discount percentage adjustment decision.
