
On March 21, 2013, the Presiding Judge held an informal conference call with counsel for Cablevision Systems Corp., Game Show Network, LLC, and the Enforcement Bureau. It was discussed, in light of questions raised by a Panel of the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit during oral argument on February 25, 2013, whether it would be worthwhile to postpone the start of the hearing until mid-July so that the participants may consider further discovery and possibly benefit from the guidance of the Court should it release its decision on *Comcast Cable Comm. v. FCC* before then.¹

The parties have conferred on this matter and have indicated by e-mail that they agree that it would be best for the hearing to be continued until July.

Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that the hearing previously scheduled to start on April 2, 2013 **IS CANCELLED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the hearing **IS RESET** for July 16, 2013.
